REFLECTION

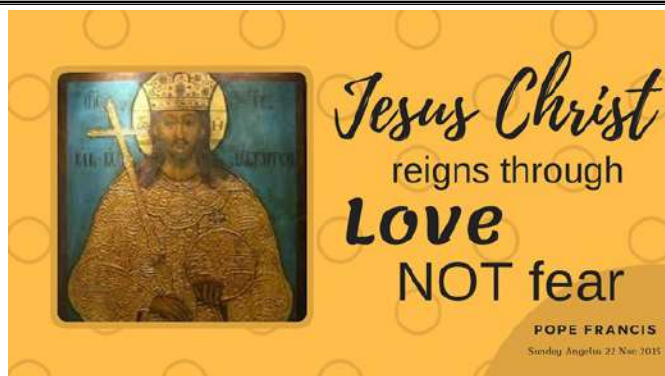
In the 2018 documentary *Won't You Be My Neighbour?* Joanne Rogers, the wife of famous children's television host Fred Rogers, recalls one of the last conversations she shared with her husband as he lay dying from stomach cancer. He asked her, "Do you think I'm a sheep?" In the documentary, Joanne says she knew just what Fred was referring to, as he'd been meditating on the same gospel reading that we have for today.

Today we celebrate Christ the King Sunday, our final Sunday of the church year and, fittingly, our gospel speaks to us at what will happen at the end of time "when the Son of Man comes in his glory." He will sit in judgement of the nations, and if we were wondering how we will be judged, Jesus spells it out. Those who enter into the kingdom of heaven will be the ones who fed the hungry, gave water to the thirsty, welcomed the stranger, clothed the naked, cared for the sick, and visited the imprisoned. These are the non-negotiable actions of discipleship. When we show love and care for others, we are loving and caring for Christ, and when we insulate ourselves from suffering and turn away, we are rejecting Christ.

Joanne Rogers answered the question of her husband (who had been ordained to the Presbyterian church as "an evangelist to television" and dedicated his career to standing up for and nourishing the lives of young children) in this way: "If there ever were a sheep, Fred, you're one." Let's take some time this Sunday to consider, if someone were to look objectively at the actions that have made up our life, would we be identified as a sheep or a goat?
